

General Guidelines

- All distances are in yards.
- Sprinkler heads and vardage markers on the fairways are measured to the front of the green except par 3.
- 3 Fixing of Hole Flags Front of Green Centre of Green Back of Green
- Players are requested to have their carts and shoes cleaned while crossing over from GP course to AP course and vice-

LOCAL RULES - GARY PLAYER COURSE

. Out of bounds (Rule-27):

- (a) Beyond the perimeter fence of the course.
- (b) Defined by white stakes/lines to the left of hole 7, right of green 9, left of hole 10, left of hole 11 and 12, behind green 12 and behind greens 9 and 18.
- (c) Boundary shared with Arnold Palmer course on left of hole 15, behind green 16, back of tee box 17 and left of hole

- Where out of bounds is defined by a line, the line itself is out of bounds.
- Where out of bounds is defined by a fence or line of white stakes, the line joining the nearest inside points at ground level of such stakes or any inside fence posts (excluding angled supports) defines the boundary. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies beyond such a line.
- iii. Objects defining out of bounds are deemed to be fixed, therefore relief without penalty from them is not available.
- 2. Water Hazards, Including Lateral Water Hazards (Rule 26)
- (a) Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes/lines.
- (b) Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes/lines.
